





TOOLS REQUIRED



3/8" Drive Ratchet with 4" extension 1/2" & 9/16" Deep Sockets



1/2" & 9/16" Combination Wrenches

STOCK EXHAUST SYSTEM REMOVAL


- 1. Loosen the bolt from the pinch clamp on the front end of each muffler.
- 2. Working with one muffler at a time, support the muffler (assistance may be required) while removing the 5/16" bolts securing the mufflers to the stock muffler hanger brackets. Save bolts for reuse.
- **3.** Remove the stock mufflers by sliding them back off the stock headers. **NOTE:** It may be necessary to use a penetrating lubricant to loosen the muffler from the head pipe.

VANCE & HINES EXHAUST INSTALLATION

- 1. Install the Torca band clamps (supplied) over the front of each muffler so that the bolt is to the inside and the nut is facing down (**Figure 1**). **NOTE:** New band clamps are supplied, do not use old band clamps.
- 2. Install the mufflers by sliding them onto the head pipes.
- 3. Using the 5/16" bolts removed earlier, attach the mufflers to support brackets on the trike, do not tighten at this time.
- **4.** Align mufflers and tighten hardware, beginning with the 5/16" flange bolts on the mounting brackets as followed by the band clamp. Tighten 5/16" bolts to factory specs, and the band clamp to 40-45 Ft./Lbs.
- **6**. After installation and before starting motorcycle, completely clean pipes and mufflers with cleaning solvent and a clean, soft cloth that will not leave a residue. **NOTE:** Any residue, oil, or fingerprints will stain the chrome when the metal heats up.

7. Be sure to tighten all hardware before starting your motorcycle.

EXHAUST CARE (CHROME)

- 1. When installing a new set of chrome pipes, make sure your hands are clean and free of oil. After installation, thoroughly clean pipes with a soft cloth and cleaning solvent that will leave no residue (chrome wax / polish, glass cleaner, alcohol, ammonia, etc...) before starting the motorcycle. Dry with a clean towel to remove any residue before starting the motorcycle.
- 2. Avoid long periods of idling as this can cause discoloration.
- 3. Intake leaks can cause the engine to run lean and overheat, this could lead to discoloration.
- **4.** Make sure there are no exhaust leaks at the junction of the exhaust pipes and the cylinder head. We recommend replacing gaskets if they are worn.

EXHAUST CARE (BLACK)

- When installing a new set of black pipes, make sure your hands are clean and free of oil. After installation, throroughly clean pipes with warm soapy water and a soft cloth. Dry with a clean towel to remove any residue before starting the motorcycle. Do NOT use anything abrasive to clean pipes.
- 2. Avoid long periods of idling as this can cause discoloration.
- 3. Intake leaks can cause the engine to run lean and overheat, this could lead to discoloration.
- 4. Make sure there are no exhaust leaks at the junction of the exhaust pipes and cylinder head. We recommend replacing gaskets if they are worn.
